

**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR
RENTING THE PAVILION
BLUE RIDGE PARK
NEW MILFORD BOROUGH**

The following rules and regulations must be agreed to by any persons who wish to use the pavilion in New Milford Borough at the Blue Ridge Park on Church Street:

~The applicant must give 30-days notice before the event.

~Rental fees are as follows:

***\$75.00 plus \$100 deposit for the pavilion** – Sunday 12 to 5:00
Monday through Saturday 12 to 7

The deposit will be returned after premises have been inspected and are found to be in satisfactory condition.

(\$2.00 per person to use the pool)

(The bathrooms will be open during these times)

(The pool will be open during these times during the summer season)

**These fees are nonrefundable unless notice of cancellation is given 30 days before the event.*

**If you need to get into the park earlier, contact Simon Frailey at least 48 hours before your party at (570) 557-9237 to make arrangements.*

~The application must be filled out completely and returned with payment 30 days prior to the event.*

**Payment must be made prior to the event. If payment is not received 30 days prior to the event, said event will be considered terminated.*

~The applicant agrees to take full responsibility for those attending the event specified.

~The applicant and those attending the event specified take responsibility for their compliance with Borough Ordinance #156, Open Container Ordinance, and any other ordinances that may apply.* **(No alcoholic beverages allowed). Smoking is NOT allowed in Blue Ridge Park.**

**Copies of ordinances may be obtained for a fee at the New Milford Borough office, 948 Main Street - Suite 1 New Milford.*

~The applicant agrees to remove all litter and all evidence of the event specified by the end of their allotted time. Bring large trash bags (drum liners) to make your clean up easier!

~Only one vehicle is allowed to transport individuals to the pavilion for handicap accessibility, if necessary, and then must return to the parking lot. All other vehicles MUST remain in the parking lot. DO NOT DRIVE OVER BLACK TOPPED WALKING TRACK OR THE BASKETBALL COURT!

The applicant agrees to comply with these rules and regulations by signing the enclosed application. Upon receipt of your check and signed application, you will be issued a permit that you must bring with you and post on the pavilion on the day of your event.
